XIII. MOTION TO ENTER INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official, or the investigation of charges or complaints against a public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual, unless the public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual requests a public hearing. Except as otherwise provided by law, no public body shall hold an executive session for the discipline of an elected official for conduct related to the performance of the elected official's official duties or for the elected official's removal from office.
- B. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(8) To consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance, provided that both of the following conditions apply:

(a) The information is directly related to a request for economic development assistance that is to be provided or administered under any provision of Chapter 715., 725., 1724., or 1728. or sections 701.07, 3735.67 to 3735.70, 5709.40 to 5709.43, 5709.61 to 5709.69, 5709.73 to 5709.75, or 5709.77 to 5709.81 of the Revised Code, or that involves public infrastructure improvements or the extension of utility services that are directly related to an economic development project.

(b) A unanimous quorum of the public body determines, by a roll call vote, that the executive session is necessary to protect the interests of the applicant or the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project.

If a public body holds an executive session to consider any of the matters listed in divisions (G)(2) to (8) of this section, the motion and vote to hold that executive session shall state which one or more of the approved matters listed in those divisions are to be considered at the executive session.




Exhibit B – GIS Aerial Vicinity Map

If, within seven (7) days after notice is given pursuant to this Resolution, the owner of the Property fails to abate, control, or remove the vegetation, garbage, refuse, or other debris as previously described, or no agreement for its abatement, control, or removal is entered into under R.C. § 505.87(D), the Board shall provide for the abatement, control, or removal of such nuisance and may employ the necessary labor, materials, and equipment to perform the task.

I. All costs incurred to abate, control, or remove the vegetation, garbage, refuse, or other debris previously described, when approved by the Board, shall be paid out of the Township general fund from moneys not otherwise appropriated.

J. Pursuant to R.C. § 505.87, the Board shall collect the total cost of abating, controlling, or removing the vegetation, garbage, refuse, junk vehicles and other debris and trash from the Property. To do so, the Board shall make a written report to the Miami County Auditor of the Board's action. The Board shall include in the report a proper description of the Property and a statement of all expenses incurred and the date of their incurrence in providing for the abatement, control, or removal of any vegetation, garbage, refuse, junk vehicles and other debris and trash from the Property, including the Board's costs for its services, the costs incurred in providing notice, any fees or interest paid to borrow moneys, and the amount paid for labor, materials, and equipment to abate the nuisance contained on the Property.

K. On behalf of the Board, the Fiscal Offer shall prepare the report described in Section J above and provide such report to the Board for approval. Once approved by the Board, the Fiscal Offer shall deliver the report,

along with a certified copy of this Resolution, any notices issued, and a certified copy of the Resolution approving the report, to the Miami County Auditor.

L. The costs incurred, when allowed, shall be entered upon the tax duplicate, are a lien upon the Property from the date of the entry, shall be collected as other taxes, and shall be returned to the Township and placed in the Township general fund.

M. All formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board, and all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including R.C. § 121.22.

N. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
