Phoneton Water Project

Bethel Township, in conjunction with Miami County Sanitary Engineering and Access Engineering has completed the engineering and design work on the Phoneton Water Project. This project will extend the waterline from Brandt to Phoneton. For a detailed look at the route, please see the picture below. The engineering cost of this project is \$177,000 which the township has paid for, in entirety, using money from the 3.8 mil Levy Fund. The construction portion of the project is estimated at \$2.5 million. To offset this amount and reduce the cost of the assessments, the township has contributed \$1 million from the 3.8 mil Levy Fund. The project was fortunate to receive a \$400,000 grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC). The remaining \$1.1 million which will be

paid immediately after construction by a \$200,000 0% OPWC loan and a \$900,000 loan from the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) which has a low interest rate, to be determined when the final bid is received. Historically, it has been less than 2%. The two loans will be repaid through property assessments. The 153 properties that will benefit from the water will be assessed no more than \$8000, to be paid back over 20 years. 2.1 mil Road Levy Fails

This past November, a 2.1 mil Road & Bridge Levy did not pass. What does this mean for our township roads? Frugal spending combined with conservative estimating suggest that the township, with current funding, can repave one mile of road approximately every three to four years. This makes the "paving cycle" for all 25 miles possible only every 75-100 years. We will continue to work with the funds that we have, crack sealing and patching will become more

frequent and re-paving of roads less frequent.

The trustees are very conscious of the need to keep taxes as low as possible. Every effort is made to reduce costs and to keep expenses at a minimum. With the substantial loss of annual tax revenue to the general fund (both state and local) over the last few years, combined with the increase in asphalt, salt, insurance, salaries, vehicle and fuel costs, we will continue to do the best job we can to maintain the integrity and safety of our roads and our community with limited funding.

Winter Road Tips

The winter months are upon us and so far this season we have had unseasonably warm weather. The prospect of snow and ice seems very remote. However, it is Ohio and we all know that cold weather, icy roads and snow are to be expected. During snow and ice storms, the Bethel Township Road Department makes every effort to keep roadways as safe as possible for drivers. Please note that in an effort to reduce costs, we will not plow between the hours of 1 a.m.—5 a.m. unless storm conditions dictate otherwise.

Plowing Responsibilities

The Bethel Township Road Department maintains approximately 25 miles of the 75 miles of roadway within the township. Other government agencies or private concerns maintain the other 49 miles.

- The Ohio Department of Transportation (937) 339-1921 maintains all state routes: 201, 202, 40 and 571.
- The Miami County Engineer's Office (937) 440-5656 maintains County roads: Studebaker, Rudy, Ross, Scarff (north of New Carlisle Road), Palmer and Dayton-Brandt
- Mobile home parks have streets maintained by the owners of the park.

Friendship Park Gets New Bathroom

A new bathroom is nearing completion at Friendship Park. The bathroom has both men's and women's facilities as well as an outside drinking fountain. The project was started in October and is only waiting on the exterior doors to be finished. It will open up for full operations in the spring of 2016. The bathrooms will be open from approximately April 1st thru October 1st each year and will be closed and winterized November through March. Care was given to make sure



quality materials were used during construction to keep maintenance costs low. "This bathroom opens up opportunities for a multitude of activities to take place in the park" stated Andy Ehrhart, Bethel Township Administrator. Currently there is a baseball/softball diamond and playground equipment located in the park. "We want to be able to apply for grants to add a few things to the park, such as a walking trail and exercise stations. Providing proper facilities was a big first step." Ehrhart said. The park was constructed with the assistance of a \$36,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The remainder of the funds came from the 3.8 mil Levy Fund. Have suggestions for uses in the park?
