A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUIRED ADOPTION OF THE 2017 TAX BUDGET AND FORWARDING THE APPROPRIATE INFORMATION TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION OF MIAMI COUNTY, AS PERMITTED THROUGH SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AUTHORIZES AND EMPOWERS A COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY, TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT ADOPT A TAX BUDGET, AS IS PROVIDED IN SECTION 5705.28 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND REQUIRE SUCH TAXING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, INCLUDING DIVIDING THE RATES OF EACH OF THE SUBDIVISION'S OR TAXING UNIT'S TAX LEVIES AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 5705.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO, HAS AUTHORIZED AND PERMITS THE TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT WITHIN MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO, TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET, AND HAS DESIGNATED THE INFORMATION WHICH THE SAID BUDGET COMMISSION REQUIRES OF EACH TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT TO PERMIT THE BUDGET COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

WHEREAS, IT IS THE DESIRE AND INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY AS THE TAXING AUTHORITY OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO ELECT TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2017, AND, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO SUBMIT TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION THE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS WHICH IT HAS INDICATED WILL BE NECESSARY IN THE ABSENCE OF SUCH ADOPTION; AND

WHEREAS, PREVIOUSLY ENACTED RESOLUTION #16-07-056, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY DECLARED IT'S SAID DESIRE AND INTENTION, AND AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO PREPARE AND TO SUBMIT TO THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE NECESSARY INCIDENT TO SAID PROCESS AND SUBMISSION, AND TO TAKE SUCH ACTIONS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY INCIDENT THERETO; AND,

WHEREAS, THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HAVE EXAMINED SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS AND APPROVE THE SAME; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY THAT; SECTION 1. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY DECLARES THAT THE MEMBERS OF SAID BODY HAVE EXAMINED THE CONTENTS OF THE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN PREPARED BY THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR SUBMISSION TO THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION UNDER THE ALTERNATIVE TAX DOCUMENT FORMAT PROVIDED BY SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017, AND THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY APPROVES THE SAME; AND

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY AUTHORIZES AND DIRECTS THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP TO SUBMIT SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS TO THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, AND TO TAKE SUCH OTHER ACTIONS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY INCIDENT OF SAID SUBMISSIONS: AND

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT ALL DELIBERATIONS AND ACTIONS RELATED TO THE FOREGOING WHERE EFFECTED IN OPEN AND PUBLIC SESSION ND IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 121.22 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND OTHERWISE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION TO REPLACE A FIRE LEVY ON THE NOVEMBER 2016 BALLOT

The Board of Trustees of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 12th day of July, 2016 at the Township Hall located at 8735 South Second Street in Brandt, Tipp City, Ohio 45371,

Ms./Mr. _____ moved for the adoption of the following Resolution.

WHEREAS, it appears that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements needed for fire protection within the unincorporated area of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio, and it is the intention of the Board of Trustees to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio, two thirds of

all members elected or appointed thereto concurring that it is deemed necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the unincorporated area of Bethel Township for the purposes of

FIRE PROTECTION

As permitted by Section 5705.19 (I) of the Ohio Revised Code, at a proposed rate not exceeding four and nine tenths (4.9) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation which amounts to forty nine cents (\$0.49) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, to be first levied and placed on the tax lists and duplicate for the tax year 2017, and continuing for tax years 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021, to be first due and first collected in the calendar year 2018, and continuing to be due and collected in calendar years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022; which proposed levy shall be a **REPLACEMENT LEVY** of an existing levy for like purpose, which existing levy is at a rate not exceeding two (2) mills which amounts to twenty cents (\$0.20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation and which proposed **REPLACEMENT LEVY** is an increase of two and nine tenths (2.9) mills, and constituting a **REPLACEMENT LEVY** as is described in sections 5705.03(B) and 5705.192(B) of the Ohio Revised Code; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said unincorporated area of Bethel Township at the General Election to be held at the usual voting places within said Bethel Township on the 8th day of November, 2016; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby requests the Auditor of Miami County, Ohio to certify to the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township that

1. The total current tax valuation of Bethel Township and the total valuation of the unincorporated area of Bethel Township; and
2. The dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by such four and nine tenths (4.9) mills replacement levy on an annual basis upon said valuation as set forth hereinabove, as is required by the terms and provisions of section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio is hereby directed to certify a true and complete copy of this Resolution, and to direct the same to the Auditor of Miami County, Ohio; and further, that she request that said officer cause the certifications alluded to herein above, as are required under Section 5705.03 (B) to be provided to the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio, as soon as may be practicable hereafter.
