PUBLIC COMMENT FOR ITEMS ON AGENDA

Resident Joe Sumpter commented that he thinks the cost of the removal of the trees at the Property on the corner of Rt40 and Second Street and the Field Installation of two Ball Fields are too costly. He would like to see the Trustees table these.

The Trustees explained to Mr. Sumpter, although they appreciated his comments and concerns, the ball fields were already installed and the quotes have already been excepted in the tree removal. The Trustees stated that the diameter and height of these trees were beyond the scope of what our Road Crew was able to do in a safe manner. The Trustees also explained that the cost of both projects are in line with similar projects.

Mr. Sumpter also asked the Trustees to purchase the property at the corner of State Rt40 and State Rt 202 to clean it up. The Trustees said the price of that property would far exceed what the Township could pay.
