

**RESOLUTION 13-07-69**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY  
TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**

WHEREAS, it appears that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Bethel Township , Miami County, Ohio, and the Board of Trustees of said Township, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B), requested and secured from the Auditor of Miami County, Ohio, the certification of said official as to the total tax valuation of the property within the incorporated and unincorporated areas of said township which is \$138,829,360.00, and of the estimated tax revenue that will be produced annually by three and eight-tenths (3.80) mills, assuming the tax valuation of the property within the incorporated and unincorporated area of the Township remains constant throughout the life of the levy, which is calculated to be \$443,898.01; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Bethel Township,

Miami County, Ohio, no fewer than two-thirds (2/3) of all of the members thereof concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the incorporated and unincorporated areas of said Township for the purpose of funding:

**THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP,  
MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO**

as permitted by Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, in a total rate and amount not exceeding three and eight-tenths (3.80) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to 38 cents (\$0.38) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, to be levied for five (5) years, to be placed upon the tax lists and duplicate for the current tax year 2013, as is permitted by Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code, to be first

due in calendar year 2014, and to remain on the tax lists and duplicate for the tax years 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017, and to be collected in the calendar years 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018, which proposed levy shall be a **RENEWAL LEVY**, which shall renew an existing levy in the same amount and for the same purpose, and which will effect the imposition of taxation for said purpose;

RESOLVED, that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Bethel Township, Miami County, Ohio, at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within the said area on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2013; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the tax levy be placed upon the tax lists and duplicate and to remain on the tax lists and duplicate as is set forth hereinabove, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor of said proposal; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of Bethel Township Miami County, Ohio, be, and said officer hereby is authorized and directed to certify a true and correct copy of this Resolution, and to direct the same to the Board of Elections of Miami County, Ohio, and, further, that said officer request that the said Board of Elections cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

#### **A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 AND ADOPTING THE ALTERNATIVE TAX BUDGET FORMAT, AS PERMITTED THROUGH SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE**

**WHEREAS**, SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AUTHORIZES AND EMPOWERS A COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY, TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT ADOPT A TAX BUDGET, AS IS PROVIDED IN SECTION 5705.28 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE., AND REQUIRE SUCH TAXING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, INCLUDING DIVIDING THE RATES OF EACH OF THE SUBDIVISION'S OR TAXING UNIT'S TAX LEVIES AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 5705.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

**WHEREAS**, PURSUANT OF THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5705.381 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AND AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AND AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO. HAS AUTHORIZED AND PERMITS THE TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT WITHIN MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO, TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET, AND HAS DESIGNATED THE INFORMATION WHICH THE SAID BUDGET COMMISSION REQUIRES OF EACH TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT TO PERMIT THE BUDGET COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

**WHEREAS**, IT IS THE DESIRE AND INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO ELECT TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2014, AND, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO SUBMIT TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION THE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS WHICH IT HAS INDICATED WILL BE NECESSARY IN THE ABSENCE OF SUCH ADOPTION; NOW

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUIRED ADOPTION OF THE 2014 TAX BUDGET AND FORWARDING THE APPROPRIATE INFORMATION TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION OF MIAMI COUNTY, AS PERMITTED THROUGH SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE**

WHEREAS, SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AUTHORIZES AND EMPOWERS A COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY, TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT ADOPT A TAX BUDGET, AS IS PROVIDED IN SECTION 5705.28 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND REQUIRE SUCH TAXING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, INCLUDING DIVIDING THE RATES OF EACH OF THE SUBDIVISION'S OR TAXING UNIT'S TAX LEVIES AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 5705.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

WHEREAS, THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HAVE EXAMINED SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS AND APPROVE THE SAME; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY THAT; SECTION1. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY DECLARES THAT THE MEMBERS OF SAID BODY HAVE EXAMINED THE CONTENTS OF THE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN PREPARED BY THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR SUBMISSION TO THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION UNDER THE ALTERNATIVE TAX DOCUMENT FORMAT PROVIDED BY SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISE CODE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014, AND THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY APPROVES THE SAME; AND

SECTION2. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY HEREBY AUTHORIZES AND DIRECTS THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP TO SUBMIT SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS TO THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, AND TO TAKE SUCH OTHER ACTIONS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY INCIDENT OF SAID SUBMISSIONS: AND
