BETHEL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS:

The Bethel Township Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) will meet in regular session on June 28, 2012 to hear the following cases:

V-04-12: A request from Paul Galloway, 8445 Heilman Dr., New Carlisle, OH, 45344. The applicant requests a variance under Article 5.05 of the Bethel Township Zoning Resolution to reduce the side yard setback from the required fifteen feet (15’) to approximately nine feet (9’) on a property located in a General Agricultural (A-2) zoning district.

V-05-12: A request from John Cooley, 7580 State Route 571, New Carlisle, OH, 45344. The applicant requests a variance under Article 5.05 of the Bethel Township Zoning Resolution to increase the maximum size of permitted accessory structure from the required twenty four hundred (2400) square feet to approximately thirty four hundred and forty (3440) square feet located in a Domestic Agricultural (A-1) zoning district.

ADMINISTRATORS REPORT

On your Agenda tonight:

Resolution 12-06-087 This is the renewal of the life and disability insurance for members of the Fire Department from Provident Life and Accident Insurance Company. There is a 3% increase on the premium, but the rate is locked for three (3) years.

Resolution 12-06-088 Staff requests approval to apply for a Home Depot “Community Impact Grant” for a grant for supplies to repaint the firehouse bays and to install energy efficient lighting into the five (5) bays. The grant requires no matching funds. The grant amount could be up to \$5,000.00.

Resolution 12-06-089 The FEMA AFG for 2011 included \$60,500.00 for the purchase of new 800 MHz radios. You have already

approved the purchase of \$44,631.17 in radios in March of this year via Resolution #12-03-054.

We have not received or been billed for that purchase. WS Communications will bill the Township for the entire \$55,334.57 for the purchases made through this Resolution and Resolution #12-03-054 at time of delivery. The Township is responsible for 5% of the total cost, or \$2,766.73. We will submit the paperwork for these purchases at that time. We will be reimbursed \$52,567.84 within 30 to 45 days after complete submission.

Resolution 12-06-090

This Resolution allows for the submission of a 2012 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) application for a new medic unit. Current Medic 2 is a 2002 Ford unit and should be replaced per NFPA standards.

This would be for a commercial chassis Freightliner medic unit at a cost of \$220,000.00 from the state bid pricing.

If awarded, this grant would require a 5% match from the Township. That 5% match would be \$11,000.00. This fits within the current Fire Department budget.

Resolution 12-06-091

This Resolution would also authorize staff to submit for an additional 2012 FEMA AFG for EMS and Fire supplies.

This grant requests \$55,000.00 to replace two (2) Heart Monitor/Defibrillators that will be obsolete and unable to be serviced in 2014. We are also requesting two (2) Power Cot units at \$30,000.00, \$33,000.00 for 15 sets of new fire gear and \$5,000.00 for new Toughbook computers for Medic 1 and Medic 2. Total grant request is for \$246,000.00.

If awarded, this grant would require a 5% match from the Township. That 5% match would be \$12,300.00. This fits within the current Fire Department budget.

GENERAL UPDATES:

Wildcat Road Closure:

Works continues on Wildcat Road north of US 40. I have been promised that road closures will be kept to a minimum now that the laterals have been installed on this part of the road. I have alerted Aileron to this information.

Phoneton Monthly Progress Meeting:

Next meeting is Wednesday, June 27 at 11:00AM. We will also be meeting with Underground Utilities, Miami County Sanitary Engineering, ODOT and Miami County Engineering to assess the road conditions in the Phoneton Contract area.

A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013 AND ADOPTING THE ALTERNATIVE TAX BUDGET FORMAT, AS PERMITTED THROUGH SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, SECTION 5705.281 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AUTHORIZES AND EMPOWERS A COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY, TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT ADOPT A TAX BUDGET, AS IS PROVIDED IN SECTION 5705.28 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE., AND REQUIRE SUCH TAXING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, INCLUDING DIVIDING THE RATES OF EACH OF THE SUBDIVISION'S OR TAXING UNIT'S TAX LEVIES AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 5705.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

WHEREAS, PURSUANT OF THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5705.381 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MIAMI COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION, BY AND AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, INCLUDING AND AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY THE AUDITOR OF MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO. HAS AUTHORIZED AND PERMITS THE TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT WITHIN MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO, TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET, AND HAS DESIGNATED THE INFORMATION WHICH THE SAID BUDGET COMMISSION REQUIRES OF EACH TAXING AUTHORITY OF A SUBDIVISION OR OTHER TAXING UNIT TO PERMIT THE BUDGET COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES UNDER CHAPTER 5705 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND

WHEREAS, IT IS THE DESIRE AND INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, MIAMI COUNTY TO ELECT TO REFRAIN FROM ADOPTING A TAX BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2013, AND, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO SUBMIT TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION THE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS
